| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> | 50-70' x 10-12' | Medium, 12"+/yr. | Elegant, tall slender pyramid | Dark shiny green with white x-shaped markings on the underside. | Fan-shaped sprays | |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Aurea' | 8-10'/10 yrs. | 9-12"/yr. | Upright broad | Outer foliage is golden yellow, while the interior is green. | Fan-shaped sprays | One of the oldest cultivars still in the trade. |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Compacta' | | 12-18"/yr. | Pyramidal | Rich blue-green, brownish-green in winter. | Fan-like | Stringy bark |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Confucius' | 5-10' @ 10 yrs. | 6-12"/yr. | Full, upright | Bright lemon-yellow on outermost foliage, surrounded by darker shades of yellow, gold, and dark green on interior foliage. Orange-tinted in winter. | | |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Crippsii' | 10+ x 4' @ 10 yrs. | 12 +"/yr. | Loose, open upright small tree | Bright yellow foliage that changes to green within the plant. | Branches with frond-like branchlets curved upwards, full elongated sprays | Sun or filtered shade. |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Filicoides' | 5-7' x 4-5' | | Open, irregular | Dark green, fern-like, pendulous foliage. | Fern-like | |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Gold Drop' | 2-3' x 2-3' | | | Golden yellow | | Can be grown in full sun without burning. |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Golden Sprite' | 1.5-2' @ 10 yrs. | Less than 3"/yr. | Globose. Rounded little bun-shaped plant | Tipped bright yellow, gradually shaded to green toward interior. | Small, thin foliage | Smallest golden Hinoki. Excellent trough or rock garden plant. |

| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Little Linda' | 3-5' @ 10 yrs. | 3-6"/yr | Similar to 'Nana Gracilis' with more upright branching. | Green | | |

| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Nana Lutea' | 3-5' @ 10 yrs. | 3-6"/yr. | Compact, pyramidal | Golden yellow | Foliage held in elegant swirls. | Part shade or full sun |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Rigid Dwarf' | 3-5' & 10 yrs. | 3-6"/yr. | Rigid upright branching. Upright broad | Rich green with copper branch tips. | | |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Snowkist' | 2-3' @ 10 yrs. | 2-4"/yr. | Habit lower than Nana Gracilis | Dark green with creamy-white variegated patches. | | Good rock garden accent. |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Split Rock' | 5-6' @ 10 yrs | 6-8"/yr. | Compact, pyramidal | Green adult foliage & blue juvenile foliage | Textural interest with adult & juvenile foliage | Bluest obtusa available. |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Tetragona Aurea' | 5-6' x 3' | 6-8" | Tall, upright, full & conical | New growth very yellow | Upright branching | Striking accent plant. |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Torulosa' | 5-6' @ 10 yrs | 6-8"/yr. | Broad, upright | New foliage light green | Threadlike foliage, curled & contorted. Small cockscombs often form on new foliage tips. | |
| <i>Chamaecyparis obtusa</i> 'Tsatsumi' | 3-5' | 3-6"/yr. | Broad, upright | Green | Rugose foliage that twists & curls | More compact than Torulosa. Accent plant in rock gardens or small landscapes. |

| <i>Chamaecyparis pisifera</i> 'Boulevard' | 6-10' x 3' | Medium, 5-6' @ 10 yrs. | High & rather narrow pyramid | Silvery blue-green in summer and grayish blue in winter. | Needle-like | Reasonably heat tolerant. A mutation of 'Squarrosa' |
| <i>Chamaecyparis pisifera</i> 'Curley Top' | 6-15' in 10-15 yrs. | 6-12"/yr. | Broader but more compact than 'Boulevard' | Bright powdery blue | Distinctive curled needles. | |
| <i>Chamaecyparis pisifera</i> 'Filifera Aurea' | 15-20' | | Dense mound | Golden | Drooping, stringy | Accent |
| <i>Chamaecyparis pisifera</i> 'Filifera Aurea Nana' | 3-4' x 4-5' | Slow | Branchlets weep downward to the tips. | Yellowish-green to golden yellow | Thread-like | For accent or foundation. |
| <i>Chamaecyparis pisifera filifera aurea</i> 'Gold Mop' | 3-5' in 10-15 yrs. | Medium, 3-6"+ | Low mounding, globose | Intense yellow | Thread-like | Wonderful planted in a group with other dwarf conifers, especially blue ones. |
| <i>Chamaecyparis pisifera filifera</i> 'Gold Spangle' | 10' | | Upright conical | Bright golden yellow | Short & slightly twisted | |
| <i>Chamaecyparis pisifera filifera</i> 'Lemon Yellow' | 2-3' x 2' | | Dense | Rich lemon yellow | Thread-like, weeping, with some juvenile foliage remaining | |
