 - Do not use around food, while the label suggests this can be used near vegetables/fruits, this chemical has not had conclusive data on it's effects on humans or animals.
- Spurge Power (Monterey Product) Concentrate 1pt. \$19.99
 - Post-Emergent Selective Broadleaf Herbicide for Residential Lawns
 - Active Ingredients:
 - 56.14% Isooctyl Ester MCPA Acid
 - 5% Butoxyethanol Ester of Triclopyr Acid
 - Dicamba Acid 3.6%
 - O CONTROLS:
 - Chickweeds
 - Dandelions
 - Clover

 - Wild Violet

- Most broadleaf "weeds" (all of the aforementioned plants are beneficial to our environment and can be affordable & sustainable alternatives to lawn grass.)
- USE ON:
 - All broadleaf "weeds" (Many "weeds" are beneficial and often even native to our environment and can be affordable & sustainable alternatives to lawn grass.)
- Chickweed, Clover & Oxalis Killer (Bonide product) Concentrate: 16oz \$14
 - Selective weed control (advertised to kill weeds but not perennials, shrubs & trees)
 - Active Ingredients:
 - Dimethyamine Salt of 2-Methyl-4-Chlorophenoxyacetic Acid
 - Triethylamine Salt of 3, 5, 6-Trichloro-2-Pyridinyloxyacetic Acid
 - Dimethylamine Salt of Dicamba (3,6-Dichloro-o-Anisic Acid)
 - OCONTROLS:
 - Chickweed
 - Speedwell
 - Veronica
 - Ground Ivy
 - Broadleaf weeds (like Dandelion)
 - OUSE ON:
 - Around the base of:
 - Perennials
 - Shrubs
 - Trees
 - Ornamental plants
 - Use this with extreme care. The active chemicals are toxic to animals, humans and our native pollinators!
 - Most weeds this product targets can be controlled manually & by planting aggressive native plants in their stead.
 - Putting down a layer of cardboard for 1 growing season will also have the same effect without harming you or the environment.
- Herbicide helper (Monterey product) Concentrate: 16oz \$7.99
 - Spreader & penetrant to be paired with Herbicides (both selective & nonselective)
 - Active Ingredient:
 - Petroleum distillate
 - Alkylphenol Ethoxylate
 - USE:
 - Use with Herbicides to make them more effective
 - **We recommend this for areas overrun with invasive plants/weeds, but use when pollinators and animals are not as active (dusk, daybreak, winter time)

- Remuda Full Strength (Monterey product) Concentrate: 1qt. \$28 1pint \$14
 - Post Emergence Herbicide
 - Active Ingredient:
 - Glyphosate (the main ingredient in RoundUp)
 - CONTROLS:
 - All vegetation
 - All ornamental plants
 - Basically effective at keeping a lawn happy and no plants
 - OUSE ON:
 - Anything you don't want to live
 - **Only recommended for use on heavy invasive plant issues!!
 - Glyphosate has NOT been labeled as carcinogenic according to any global health or regulatory organization HOWEVER this product needs to be handled with extreme care. Glyphosate is harmful to our environment and while handling the product properly will not necessarily result in health issues, having the run-off compound in our water and soil WILL cause health issues; handle with extreme care.

Chemicals to Beware of & Chemical Tips:

- Just because a label has an "OMRI" (Organic Materials Review Institute) seal of organic gardening approval does NOT mean it is safe for our pollinators or YOU!
 - The term "organic" is <u>not</u> currently regulated for many non-food products such as pet food, **cosmetics**, household products and **fertilizers**. These products may meet non-government, privately maintained standards, but the use of the term "organic" on labels is not federally regulated for these non-food products.
 - For example, a fertilizer may be "OMRI Listed," meaning that it meets OMRI's standards for a fertilizer, but almost any fertilizer can use the term "organic" on the label. Canadian and Mexican laws are similar regarding what can and can't be called "organic."

Organic DOES NOT mean Safe - the label "organic" on any products in the USA only refers to the fact that the ingredients/pesticides used etc. are naturally occurring elements rather than man-made. While historically for the organic movement, we assumed that naturally occurring elements had to be safer than manmade elements, we have found that to not be true at all. Concentrations of any elements have extremely harmful effects on humans, animals and the environment!
